Science Centre Singapore's 2D1N *TINKER CAMP* at the Tinkering Studio returns for the third time! We are back with more design thinking workshops like 3D printing and prototyping our own arcade games. Ready, set, tinker!

Set-up in collaboration with San Francisco's Science Centre, The Exploratorium, The Tinkering Studio encourages creative learning and exploration.

The hands-on nature of *TINKER CAMP* brings out the essentiality of science and engineering in everyday settings. Campers will be introduced to working with real tools, like soldering iron, drill, hand-saw, hot glue gun, hammer, etc., under the expert supervision of our Chef Tinkerers.

Apart from learning STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) topics, *TINKER CAMP* builds a foundation of innovation, social scaffolding, and teamwork for these tinkerers who will one day pave a future of collaboration, sustainable living and confident inventors of society.

## ITINERARY (2)


